ALLOSAURUS ANSWER SHEET

- 1. The Allosaurus lived during the Jurassic period, around 150 million years ago.
- 2. The Allosaurus had bony bumps on its head, three large clawed fingers, and was smaller than a T. Rex.
- 3. Scientists think the bumps may have been used for attracting mates or protecting its eyes.
- 4. The Allosaurus stood about 10 feet tall, as tall as a two-story house!
- 5. The Allosaurus was a carnivore, which means it ate meat, mostly other dinosaurs.
- 6. It hid in trees, used its sharp teeth and claws to catch prey, and might have hunted in packs.
- 7. The Allosaurus lived in North America, in places like Utah and Colorado.
- 8. A huge meteor caused changes in the climate, making it hard for dinosaurs to survive.
- 9. "Allosaurus" means "different lizard" in Greek because it was unique compared to other dinosaurs.
- 10. The Allosaurus could run up to 25 miles per hour, about as fast as a dog!
