1. Answer: Its long neck, which could stretch over 30 feet.
2. Answer: A whip-like tail.
3. Answer: Up to 23 meters long.
4. Answer: It was an herbivore that ate vegetation, including leaves and ferns.
5. Answer: It lived in North America, particularly in areas now known as Colorado, Utah, and Wyoming.
6. Answer: It likely used its long, whip-like tail to defend itself against predators.
7. Answer: The Apatosaurus ate up to 880 pounds of vegetation daily.
8. Answer: The Brontosaurus.
9. Answer: "Deceptive lizard," due to the initial confusion about its species.
