- 1. The first bird.
- 2. During the late Jurassic period, about 150 million years ago.
- 3. Sharp teeth and a long bony tail.
- 4. It was 50 centimeters long and weighed about 2 pounds.
- 5. It was a carnivore, eating small lizards, insects, and possibly small dinosaurs.
- 6. In what is now Germany, during the late Jurassic period.
- 7. To grab food and possibly climb trees.
- 8. About 60 centimeters.
- 9. Its feathers were asymmetrical, suggesting it could at least glide.
- 10. It was discovered in 1861, two years after Charles Darwin proposed the theory of evolution.
