- 5. Its name means "Giant Southern Lizard" in Greek.
- 6. Its teeth were about six inches long, similar to the length of a pencil.
- 7. The Giganotosaurus's thick tail helped it balance and run fast.
- 8. The Giganotosaurus likely hunted in packs, similar to wolves.
- 9. The Giganotosaurus could run up to 30 miles per hour.
